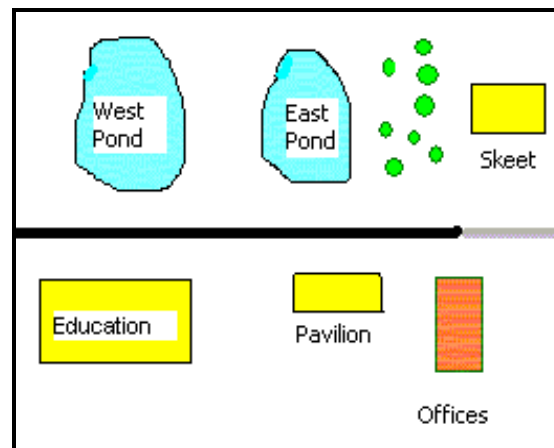

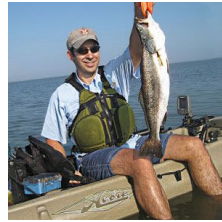
Jarid Malone
